

Diagnoses

Requests for reimbursement must be presented with a behavioral health diagnosis.

Eligible Diagnoses

| ICD-10 Diagnosis Categories | Description |
|-----------------------------|--|
| F20-F29 | Schizophrenia, schizotypal, delusional, and other non-mood psychotic disorders |
| F30-F39 | Mood (affective disorders) |
| F40-F48 | Anxiety, dissociative, stress-related, somatoform & other nonpsychotic mental disorders |
| F50 | Eating disorders |
| F52 | Sexual dysfunction not due to a substance or known physiological condition |
| F53 | Mental & behavioral disorders associated with the puerperium, not elsewhere classified |
| F54 | Psychological & behavioral factors associated with disorders or diseases classified elsewhere |
| F55 | Abuse of non-psychoactive substances |
| F59 | Unspecified behavioral syndromes associated with physiological disturbances & physical factors |
| F60-F69 | Disorders of adult personality & behavior |
| F88 | Other disorders of psychological development |
| F89 | Unspecified disorder of psychological development |
| F91 | Conduct disorders |
| F93 | Emotional disorders with onset specific to childhood |
| F94 | Disorders of social functioning with onset specific to childhood & adolescence |
| F99 | Unspecified mental disorder |

Many ICD-10 diagnosis codes in the F01-F99 range are considered eligible for reimbursement under the fund, with the **exception** of those listed below.

Diagnoses NOT ELIGIBLE for Reimbursement

| ICD-10 Diagnosis Categories | Description |
|-----------------------------|---|
| F01-F09 | Mental disorders due to known physiological conditions |
| F10-F19 | Mental & behavioral disorders due to psychoactive substance abuse |
| F51 | Behavioral syndromes associated with physiological disturbances & physical factors (limited to these codes) |
| F70-F79 | Intellectual disabilities |
| F80-F84 | Pervasive & specific development disorders (limited to these codes) |
| F90 | Attention-deficit hyperactivity disorders |
| F95-F98 | Behavioral & emotional disorders with onset usually occurring in childhood & adolescence (limited to these codes) |
